Who We Are:

We are a non-profit organization that is not part of Westosha Central High School, but works closely with boys Head Basketball Coach Brent Mansky and girls head Coach Dan Derler and members of their staffs in the development of basketball players who plan on attending high school at Westosha Central High.

We will have teams for boys and girls in grade levels 5^{th} through 8^{th} grade.

The primary purpose of the club program is to provide an outlet for boys and girls at the various schools that feed into Westosha to play together and to develop skills that will help them in the future. Because the teams play against a high level of competition this is not a beginner-type basketball program and prospective players are required to participate in team tryouts.

Club Team Schedule:

Our philosophy is to organize the club program to complement and not interfere with the grade school basketball schedule. Practices will start in late October/early November. The season will end by late March or early April. Most games will be played on the weekends and practices will work around the grade school schedule.

Fees:

Our costs are only those directly related to running the basketball program – tournament fees, uniforms, etc. The club and its coaches will not be compensated in any way other than the enjoyment of coaching and developing basketball players. We will pursue some outside funding from sponsors to help defray the costs; however it is expected that the cost per player will be in the range of \$100 -\$150. All families will be asked to volunteer in some capacity during the season.
