For years, dog owners in Kenosha County have longed for a place where they could allow their dogs to run off-leash in a safe environment. Dogs that receive regular exercise and are well socialized are better canine citizens in our county.

There are more than 20 off-leash dog parks in Wisconsin cities and counties. The Kenosha County Parks Department is offering two locations – one east of I-94 and the other west of I-94 – where permanent, off-leash dog parks could be established. Permanent dog parks are planned at Petrifying Springs Park, near the park entrance at Highway JR, and at the future KD Park, 35714 89th St., near Bassett Park in the Town of Randall. There currently are temporary dog parks at Old Settlers Park, 24100 75th St., Salem, and Petrifying Springs Park, Area 3, 761 Green Bay Road, Kenosha.

Kenosha County has pledged \$25,000 in non-tax dollars and we need your help to raise a matching amount of \$25,000 to build the dog parks.
